CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

On behalf of the members of the APSCI Board and the Organising Committee of the Asia Pacific Symposium on Cochlear Implants and Related Sciences 2021 (APSCI 2021), it is our pleasure to invite submissions for oral poster presentation for the online symposium to be held 8-10th December 2021.

Submissions addressing topics including basic research, diagnostics, surgery, outcomes and habilitation are welcomed for inclusion in the scientific program. If accepted in the program, oral posters will be asked to include short pre-recorded videos and the committee particularly welcome short surgical videos on topics such as radiology, hearing preservation, malformations, reimplantation, and complications, as well as osseointegrated devices and middle ear implants.

The oral poster program will supplement a series of panel and invited lectures and industry mini-symposia. This will be a great opportunity for delegates to be updated on research findings as well as new technology from our industry colleagues. We also plan to enable networking with colleagues, an aspect that we have all sorely missed over the past year due to COVID.

The closing date for receipt of submissions is 22 September 2021. To be included in the program, authors must be registered to attend the online symposium.

Abstract Submission

Oral Poster presentations will include a digital poster and 3 minute pre-recorded video presentation. To submit an abstract for Oral Poster presentation, please follow the steps below.

1. Download and complete the abstract template

Download the Oral Poster Abstract template and prepare your abstract.

2. Create a new account in the submission portal

3. Enter your contact details

4. Submit your abstract
